



Campus Emergency Response Team (CERT)
Academy Participant Application Form

The HSU Campus Emergency Response Team is a self-contained, multi-purpose unit comprised of trained volunteer staff, faculty and students from many different departments and divisions. When a major campus event occurs, HSU will activate the CERT team and assign duties appropriate to the event. The tasks assigned include the following:

- Executing light search and rescue; extrication of trapped persons
- Providing medical first aid and triage of the injured
- Preventing and suppressing small fires
- Supporting other emergency field operations

CERT members attend a 24 hour training academy utilizing FEMA curriculum. After completing the CERT academy, members are expected to attend monthly meetings, take part in refresher events and mobilize as available during any HSU activations. Disaster drills also provide an opportunity to refine skills and integrate CERT into campus emergency functions. All safety equipment is provided.
