IF YOU ARE LEAVING OVER THE BREAK

Please:

- ◆ turn off all lights and turn heater down to 55 degrees
- ◆ check to make sure window(s) & door(s) are closed and locked
- ◆ shut drapes and/or blinds
- ◆ unplug items that do not need to be plugged in (e.g., lamps, alarms clocks, etc.)
- ◆ If you have a vehicle on campus and will be leaving it over the break, park it in a well lit area and don't leave belongings in the vehicle.

IF YOU ARE STAYING OVER THE BREAK

- ◆ In order to increase security over the break period, and for emergency purposes, we are requiring all residents staying in the halls at any time over the break period to inform his/her Community Advocate of his/her plans to stay before Friday, November 13, 2009.
- ◆ If you are staying over the break, *be extra aware in your community*: make sure building entries are locked, know who is staying on your floor, and as you would normally do, don't allow strangers into your living areas.

If you need staff assistance during the break, please call 826-3451 or come by the Housing Office or Information Desk during operational hours. When the Housing Office or Information Desk is closed, please call the University Police Department at 826-5555 for assistance.

GOT THE FLU DURING THE BREAK?

For medical advice when the Student Health Center is closed, call 1-866-724-5057. You might require immediate medical attention if you have:

- Difficulty breathing or shortness of breath
- Pain or pressure in the chest or abdomen
- Sudden dizziness
- Confusion
- Severe or persistent vomiting
- Flu-like symptoms not improving after 3-4 days or if symptoms return

In an emergency, call 911 for an ambulance to respond.

LEAVING HSU AFTER THE FALL SEMESTER?

Are you graduating or transferring from HSU? Are you with the National Student Exchange Program and only registered for one semester at HSU?

If so, you need to stop by the Housing Office and complete a request to vacate form by Thursday, November 19th, 2009. Doing so provides us with the required 30-day notice that you are vacating the residence halls because you are leaving the university. If you complete the form by November 19th, you will not be charged penalties for not providing 30 days notice. After that date, you will be charged a prorated penalty fee for each day of notice that is less than the required 30 days. If you are leaving it is very important that you complete this form.
