It is a stated goal of HSU Sponsored Programs Foundation that its operation will be conducted in compliance with applicable regulations. These applicable regulations include, but are not limited to, such subjects as uniform accounting and reporting, annual independent audit, open meeting regulations, annual publication of financial condition, comparable salaries, establishment of reserves, budgetary constraints, gifts, board structure, responsible management, operation agreements (lease), and reimbursement to the State for services performed.
