(Job #10-28) Registered Nurse I, \$21.70-\$28.00/hour. The Student Health Center is updating its pool of “on call” employees for the position of Registered Nurse I. Effective dates: August 2011-May 2013.

Position Summary: Perform a variety of primary care nursing duties. Interview patients to ascertain signs and symptoms of illness, take and record vital signs and determine appropriate processing of patients, prepare patients for physical exam and assist when appropriate, apply and change dressings, remove sutures and casts, administer immunizations and injections, perform or assist with other medical procedures, such as administering IV fluids and medications. Other duties as assigned.

Minimum Qualifications: One year of professional nursing experience in an outpatient or hospital setting preferred. Possession of a valid license as a Registered Nurse in the State of California.
