**Position Summary:** HSU is seeking an analyst/programmer to be part of a team which supports a variety of campus-wide data management functions, including reporting, identity management and database administration.

**Minimum Qualifications: Education & Experience:** A Bachelor's degree in Information Systems, Computer Science, or a closely related field. Additional relevant experience can be substituted for academic work. In addition the applicant will need to satisfy one of the following:

**Analyst/Programmer—Foundation:** One or more years of experience; or

**Analyst/Programmer—Career:** Three or more years of experience programming and creating complex SQL queries.

**Knowledge, Abilities & Specialized Skills:** The successful candidate should have a strong working knowledge of SQL queries and at least one higher level programming language, and experience designing and implementing data models (whether relational or dimensional), data mapping and data conversion. Along with technical skills, we seek candidates who are comfortable working on a team, who perform well in a busy environment, and who have the strong interpersonal skills to interact effectively with functional users.
