- Driving will only be involved if the host is not within reasonable walking distance (10 minutes) to a Redwood Transit bus stop, or there is an event in which buses do not service during scheduled activity times.
- We will have a host family orientation on June 26th. The time and location is to be announced.
- The students, faculty and staff will eat lunches together at the 'J' Monday through Friday. Host families need to provide breakfast and dinner Monday through Friday. On Saturday and Sunday the students will eat with their hosts for the three meal times.
- The students will be in academic classes from 9:30 -12:30 and there will be presentations, activities, and study time each afternoon. The last week will be a daily soccer camp. The students will still live and eat with their host families during this week.
- We have 17 American teens who will be language mentors. These teens will be taking classes with the Abu Dhabi students.
