

DIVERSITY & COMMON GROUND

Undergraduates following catalog requirements from 1993 to 2002 must complete at least two Diversity and Common Ground (DCG) courses. They may select any two courses from the list below. Effective summer 2003, students following 2003 and subsequent catalogs must complete two DCG courses and at least one of the courses must have a domestic focus (focused within the boundaries of the United States). The second course may be either domestic or international/transnational. Below is a list of currently approved DCG courses. Those that have a domestic focus are indicated with a Yes in the Domestic column. DCG courses can also satisfy other degree requirements, such as GE, major, or minor requirements. DCG courses listed here that are also approved for GE have their GE areas designated in the GE Area column.

A course used to meet a DCG requirement must be DCG approved for the term in which the course is or was taken. Courses taken in past terms that were DCG approved at the time the course was taken, will count towards the requirement. Courses that appeared in earlier catalogs or *Class Schedule & Registration Guides* as DCG approved, but do not appear on the current list of approved courses, will not count if you take them now. Courses that are added to the approved list after the printing of this *Class Schedule & Registration Guide* will appear in the Alternate Index section of the online schedule.
