



**The Charles G. Schober and Helen W. Schober Scholarship  
Elementary, Secondary, and Special Education Credential Candidates**

**Administered by the Humboldt Area Foundation**

**Background Information**

Helen W. Schober completed a bachelor's degree at Humboldt State in 1938 when it was a normal school, and a master's degree in educational administration from San Francisco State. She thoroughly enjoyed her many years of service as a teacher and school principal. She was a supervisor for the Humboldt County Office of Education (HCOE), and provided support for teachers and administrators in her role as program manager of the Humboldt Educational Resource Center. Helen was greatly esteemed by her colleagues and friends, and was known for her remarkable communication skills and generous professional contributions. Her husband, Charles, was an engineer with the California State Division of Highways.

**Available Scholarships**

Scholarships ranging from \$500 - \$1,175 are available for Elementary Education, Secondary Education, and Special Education credential candidates. The scholarships will be awarded only if there are qualified applicants. The scholarships must be used during the academic year awarded, and the award amount will be split in two, with half of the award money given each semester.

**Scholarship Selection Criteria**

Application requirements for the Charles G. Schober and Helen W. Schober Scholarship:

- 1) Contingent acceptance into the Elementary, Secondary, or Special Education credential program, including assigned apprentice teaching fieldwork placements for the coming year, and full-time HSU student status maintained during the credential program.
- 2) GPA at or above the minimum for admission to HSU's Credential Program as designated by the CSU Chancellor's Office (2.67 overall GPA or 2.75 for the last 60 semester units).
- 3) Submit a letter of application describing personal characteristics which discuss your interest in a career in teaching, potential for becoming an excellent teacher, communication skills, and leadership abilities. (You may use your **Professional Goal Statement** from your application for this.)
- 4) Submit three letters of recommendation. (You may use the letters of recommendation from your credential program application.)

**Application Process**

Applications must be submitted by **Friday, May 30, 2008 by 5:00 p.m.** to *Kristin Mack in Lower Library Office 8*. If you are mailing in your application, please mail it to:
