

CODES DESCRIPTIONS

- R RESIDENT UNITS** -- Courses taken in residence at HSU. No less than 21 semester units.
- G GRADUATE UNITS** -- Courses taken at the graduate level. Minimum of 50% of total degree units.
- C THESIS/PROJECT UNITS** -- Generally 690 courses.
- I INDEPENDENT STUDY, DIRECTED STUDY, FIELD PROBLEMS, RESEARCH, INTERNSHIP, OR PRACTICUM UNITS** -- Generally 695 or 699 Courses
- U UPPER DIVISION UNITS** -- They are 300, 400 and 700 courses at HSU.
- T TRANSFER UNITS** -- Courses taken at another institution. Transcripts must be supplied to Enrollment Management.
- E EXTENSION UNITS** -- Course taken through HSU Extended Education, not for resident credit.
- P POSTBACCALAUREATE/CREDENTIAL/SECOND BA OR BS** -- Additional professional, personal, scholastic, and other standards (including qualifying exams.)
- D DECLARED DEFICIENCIES** -- Courses which must be completed before advancement to candidacy and which are not included within the minimum required units for the degree.

- ◆ You have seven years in which to complete your program.
- ◆ The beginning of the seven years is determined by the oldest course listed on this form.
- ◆ An approved Request for Program Variation or Waiver form must be submitted for any changes to this program.
- ◆ No grade below C can count as a passing grade.
- ◆ Courses used to fulfill major requirements may not be taken on an **optional** CR/NC basis.
- ◆ No more than 1/3 of master's degree courses may be taken CR/NC.
