LILLIAN E. WOODWARD NURSING SCHOLARSHIP

Academic year 2009-2010

The Lillian E. Woodward Nursing Scholarship is established to support the education of a student pursuing a baccalaureate degree in nursing at Humboldt State University.

Scholarship Amount: \$500.00

Qualifications:

1. Enrolled, full-time student (minimum of 12 units per semester) pursuing a baccalaureate degree in nursing at Humboldt State University.
2. Admitted to Humboldt State University as pre-nursing majors, continuing students in the pre-nursing or nursing major, transfer students admitted into the pre-nursing or nursing major, or post baccalaureate in the pre-nursing or nursing major.
3. Have at least two semesters of course work yet to be completed at Humboldt State University.
4. Academic achievement as demonstrated by a cumulative minimum GPA of 2.5 (HSU and transfer courses, if applicable).

Restrictions:

1. Previous winners may be eligible to reapply and receive award in subsequent years.
2. Scholarship will not be awarded if no candidate meets the criteria.

Application procedure: Applicants must submit a completed Lillian E. Woodward Nursing Scholarship application form obtained from the Department of Nursing which shall include:

1. Letter of application (limited to 250 words, double-spaced, typewritten) describing applicant's commitment to the discipline of nursing, reasons for pursuing a baccalaureate in nursing, and professional goals. Please do not have any identifying data on this page. You will be assigned an identification number.
2. Copies of college transcripts (unofficial are acceptable).
3. One reference from a faculty member, professional in field, work supervisor, or other non-related person qualified to recommend candidate on basis of his/her qualifications for scholarship whom the scholarship committee can contact by telephone.
