

**Mac OS 10.x TCP/IP Setup**

To set up the TCP/IP configuration for Mac OS X or above, follow these easy steps from the desktop.

1. Click the **Apple icon** then System Properties
2. Click the **Network icon** (your window may vary.)
3. In the Network window by Show, select **built-in Ethernet**.
4. In the **TCP/IP** tab next to configure, select **Using DHCP**.
5. If the **Apply Now** button in the bottom right corner is available, click it. You can close the **Network** window & **System Preferences** by clicking the **System Preferences Menu and selecting Quit System Preferences**.

**Mac 8.5 to 9.x TCP/IP Setup**

To set up the TCP/IP configuration for Mac OS 8.5 to 9.x, follow these easy steps from the desktop:

1. Click the **Apple icon**, select **Control Panels**, then select **TCP/IP**.
2. In the **Connect via:** field, select **Ethernet**.
3. In the **Configure** field, select **Using DHCP Server**.
4. Click the Close box in the upper left-hand corner. When you are prompted to save the settings, click **Save**.

**– The final step for both systems**

1. If you haven't already, Read the ResNet Acceptable Use Policy (AUP)
2. **Sign** the AUP
3. Turn in your AUP to the Housing Office.
4. **Go to** <http://www.humboldt.edu/~resnet/reg.shtml> and follow the instructions

**If you do not do these last four steps or if they are incomplete, your ResNet connection will be disconnected.**
