

Windows 2000 Professional Setup

The following steps outline the procedure for setting up TCP/IP for Windows 2000 Professional.

1. Click **Start**, then **Settings**, then **Control Panel**.
2. Double-click **Network and Dial-up Connections**.
3. Double-click on **Local Area Network** and choose **Properties**.
4. If the **Client for Microsoft Networks** and **TCP/IP** are installed and boxes are checked, go to step 9.
5. If the **Client for Microsoft Networks** is not installed, click **Install**, then **Client**, then **Add**.
6. Choose **Client for Microsoft Networks** and click **OK**.
7. If the **Internet Protocol (TCP/IP)** is not installed, click **Install**, then **Protocol**, then **Add**.
8. Choose **Internet Protocol (TCP/IP)**, click **OK**.
9. To configure the Internet Protocol, choose **Internet Protocol (TCP/IP)** and click **Properties**.
10. Ensure that the radio buttons are set for **Obtain IP address automatically** and **Obtain DNS server address automatically**.
11. Click **OK**.
12. Click **Close**.

– The final step

1. If you haven't already, Read the ResNet Acceptable Use Policy (AUP)
2. **Sign** the AUP
3. Turn in your AUP to the Housing Office.
4. **Go to** <http://www.humboldt.edu/~resnet/reg.shtml> and follow the instructions

If you do not do these last four steps or if they are incomplete, your ResNet connection will be disconnected.
