

Windows XP TCP/IP Setup

The following steps outline the procedure for setting up TCP/IP for Windows XP.

1. Click **Start** and select **Control Panel**. Control panel will load in either Classic View or Category View.

For Classic View: Double-click the **Network Connections** icon.

For Category View: Select **Network and Internet Connections**, select **Network Connections**, then double-click the **Network Connections** icon.

2. Double Click the **Local Area Connection** icon.

3. On the **General** tab, Double Click **Internet Protocol (TCP/IP)** or highlight it and select **Properties**.

Note: if you don't see the general tab, click properties.

4. Select the **General** tab of the **Internet Protocol (TCP/IP) Properties** window. Make sure the radio buttons for **Obtain an IP address automatically** and **Obtain DNS server address automatically** are both selected.

5. Restart the computer..

– The final step

1. If you haven't already, Read the ResNet Acceptable Use Policy (AUP)
2. Sign the AUP
3. Turn in your AUP to the Housing Office.
4. Go to <http://www.humboldt.edu/~resnet/reg.shtml> and follow the instructions

If you do not do these last four steps or if they are incomplete, your ResNet connection will be disconnected.
