

Institutions Requirement Learning Outcomes

American History Outcomes:

1. Students will be knowledgeable about significant events in American history spanning a minimum of 100 years.
2. Students will be able to discuss the roll of important regions, ethnic groups and social groups that contribute to the American experience.
3. Students will be able to discuss American history in a framework of at least three of the following: political events, economics, social movements and geography.

U.S. and California Constitution Outcomes

1. Students will be capable of distinguishing the political philosophies of the U.S. Constitution's framers.
2. Students will be able to explain the United States Constitution's relationship to governance and specifically to the California Constitution, and their rights and responsibilities under each.
3. Students will know the relationships between different levels of government and the primary processes involved in those relationships.
