APPLICATION

1. Submit an essay in English (no more than five double-spaced, type-written pages) on the following question:

How has the study of another language at Humboldt State University affected you personally, and how do you see it affecting you professionally in the future?

2. Submit an unofficial copy of your academic transcripts; a printout is acceptable.
3. Submit personal data sheet. Include full name, student number, current address and phone number, email address, language of major or minor, and class status.

Priority will be given to upper-division students. Academic excellence will be considered primarily in language courses, secondarily in other courses.

Two candidates will be chosen by the selection committee, and the award will be announced on Friday, December 5, 2008.
