SUBJECT: An Act to Change Mixer Planning Funds from Individual to Group Allowances

WHEREAS, The Associated Students (A. S.) Council of Humboldt State University (HSU) is the single recognized voice for over 8,600 students; and,

WHEREAS, The Mission of the Associated Students of Humboldt State University serves to "assist in the protection of rights and interests of the individual student and the student body," and to "stimulate the educational, social, physical, and cultural well-being of the University community"; and,

WHEREAS, The Associated Students of Humboldt State University currently has three representatives from each college: (3) College of Arts Humanity and Social Sciences, (3) College of Professional Studies, and (3) College of Natural Resources and Sciences; and,

WHEREAS, It is the duty of the Representatives of each College to organize (2) college mixers per academic year; and,

WHEREAS, Each representative has a fifty (50) dollar budget, for the year, to contribute to planning both mixers; and,

WHEREAS, There are frequently vacant seats in each college, leaving representatives with fifty (50) to one-hundred (100) dollars rather than one-hundred fifty (150) dollars; and

WHEREAS, It is difficult to organize a meaningful or beneficial event for HSU students with one representative's allowance; and,


WHEREAS, The next A.S. Council (2017-18) will have only two Representatives per College charged with organizing both mixers, therefore be it:

RESOLVED, That the monies allocated for planning mixers will be distributed per represented College rather than per Representative; and,


RESOLVED, That each college will be allotted no less than two-hundred (200) dollars per semester, regardless of the number of seats filled and funds leftover from the fall semester may carry over to the spring semester; and,

RESOLVED, That all active Representatives of each College shall agree on how funds are spent; and finally,


