Spider Technicians: We will be hiring **1-2 paid technicians** for lab work identifying and sorting preserved spider specimens as well as participating in fieldwork collecting spiders in Humboldt redwood forests. Previous entomological/invertebrate identification experience is preferred but not required, with a pay rate of \$18/hr for a maximum of 50 hours in the Spring semester, with possible extension into the summer.


Although paid positions are limited, we are also happy to have additional students participate in the project and receive course credit, via **BIOL 490 Directed Study units**.
