 - i. Honorary Policy Review this is up next for review and possible revisions
 - ii. Name for Student Housing at former Craftsman Mall: Hinarr Hu Moulik (Our House/Home) (Phonetic spelling is: "hee-NOD huh MOO-leek") -
 - 1. This vote request came to the committee via email, with a result of mostly 'aye's and two 'needs discussion'.
 - 2. Mike Fisher explained how the stakeholder review was facilitated by Housing and generally outside of our Non-Honorary Naming Guidelines as they were not completed at the time. Dr. Holliday and Adrienne Colegrove-Raymond consulted with the Wiyot specialist. Future naming efforts for non-honorary building naming will be reviewed by USFAC per the guidelines.
 - 3. The committee discussed the concern of potential name abbreviating, and if the intent of the name is really honored if it's abbreviated or mispronounced, as well as questions

Then the Housing, Dining and Health building will be built once the Student Housing project at the former Craftsman Mall is occupied, as well as after an enrollment review. The current construction schedule is 2027-2029 for the Housing, Dining and Health project.
