**What You Need to Know  
Before You Enroll**



# > Summer 2026 Term

For the Summer 2026 term, the university guarantees that continuing matriculated **undergraduate** students enrolled in 6+ units will have 3 units of tuition covered.

- This applies only to the tuition charge and **does not** include mandatory campus-based fees which are \$481 for the term.

To be eligible, students must be:

- Continuing, matriculated, undergraduate students (including WUE students)
- Enrolled in 6 or more units within the state-side summer session
- Meeting Satisfactory Academic Progress (SAP)

\*Student who are not continuing undergraduates do not benefit from the cost assistance program.

# ➤ Summer 2026 Term, Continued

Programs and Fees **NOT** eligible for this program:

- Mandatory campus based fees
- Non-resident tuition
- Secondary bachelor's students
- Master's students
- Faculty led study abroad or field courses
- Special session courses
- Leadership Studies students
- Extension non-credit courses
- Internship, independent study, and field experience

Withdrawing or dropping courses below 6 units during the Summer Session may result in ineligibility for the Cost Assistance Program. Please visit the Financial Aid Website for more information.

However, **each student situation is different** we encourage you to connect with our office for specifics about your aid eligibility based on your unique situation.



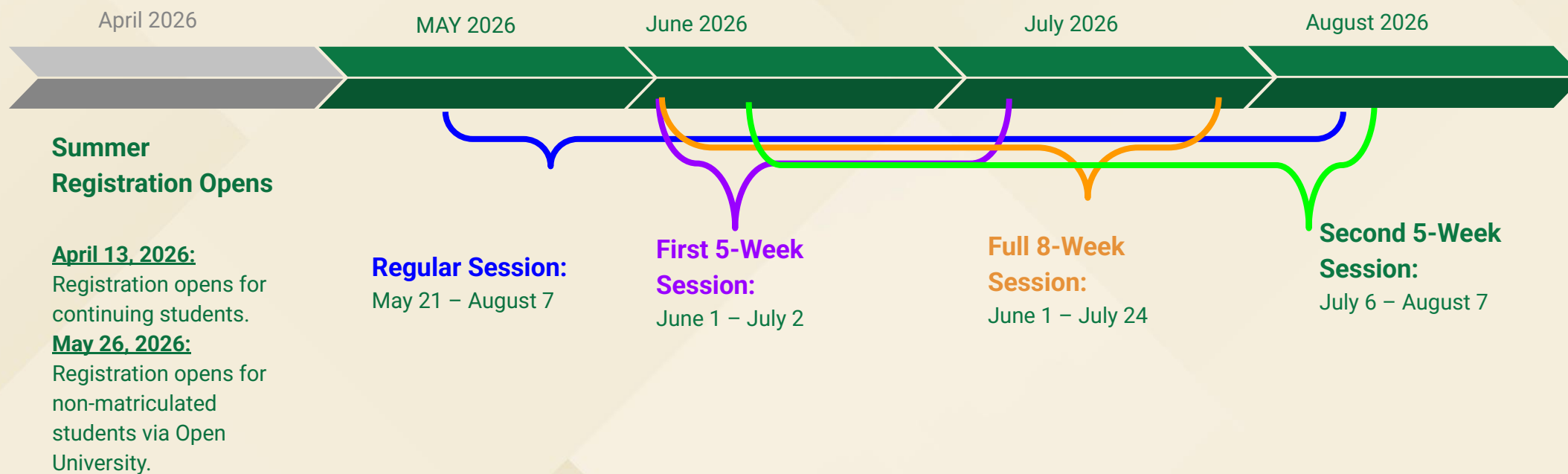

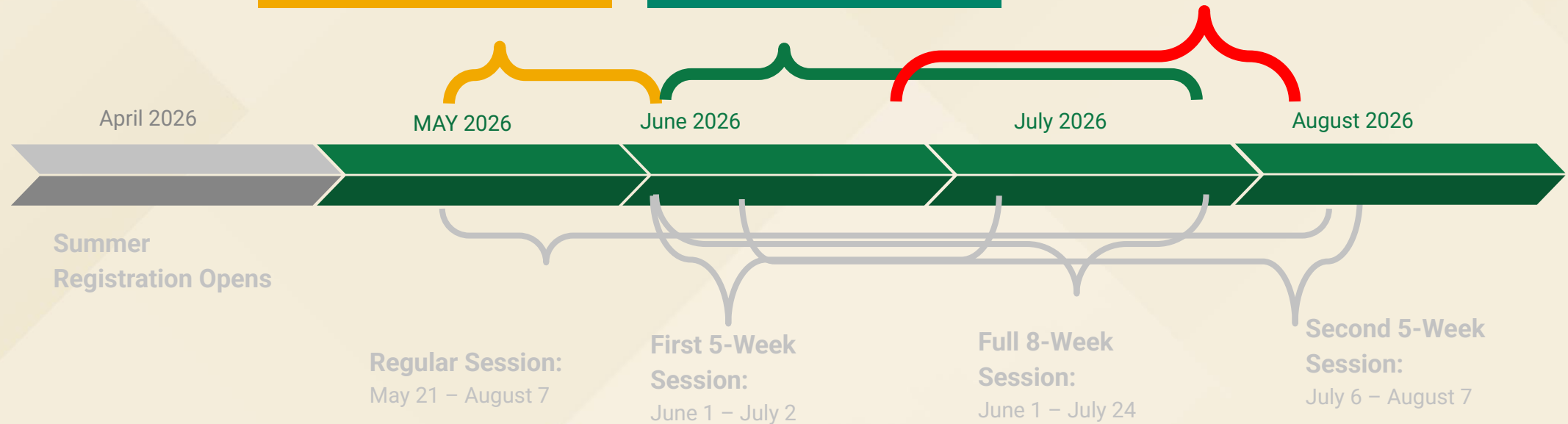


# Summer Term Overview

**Spring Term Ends, Grades due from Instructors & Official Grade Processing**  
Final Exams: May 11–15, 2026  
Spring Grades Due May 20, 2026  
Official Grades first week of June

**Evaluation of Spring SAP**  
TBD after Spring 2025 grades are official. Likely the first week of June. We cannot begin processing aid prior to the evaluation of SAP.

**Financial Aid Awarding to begin Late June**  
It's important to plan accordingly. Summer aid will not be available for the majority of students before the term begins.
