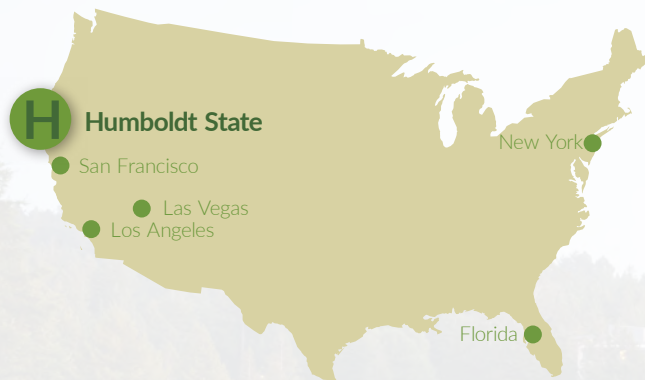

Admission Requirements

Undergraduate & HSU Study California

- 2.5 GPA on a 4.0 scale for secondary education
- 2.0 GPA on a 4.0 scale for college coursework
- TOEFL score of 525 PBT, 71 IBT or IELTS 6.0

Graduate

- Completion of an undergraduate degree
- 2.5 GPA on 4.0 scale
(some departments may require higher GPA)
- TOEFL score of 80 IBT or IELTS 6.5

One-year MBA (August through July)

- TOEFL score of 80 IBT or IELTS 6.5
- Completion of prerequisite courses
