







## California's MPA Network: By the Numbers






## Statewide MPA Monitoring Program

#### **Two-phase Approach:**

- Phase 1: Baseline (\$4m per region)
- Phase 2: Long-term (\$2.5m annually)
  - Statewide MPA Monitoring Action Plan (in development)

- Implemented December 19, 2012
- California/Oregon border to Alder Creek near Point Arena
  - 137 square miles
  - 13 percent in MPAs
- Re-designed Network
  - o 20 MPAs
  - 7 special closures
