Our paid and unpaid internships provide you with clinical observing and shadowing experience in diverse clinical environments in rural, Indigenous, urban communities.

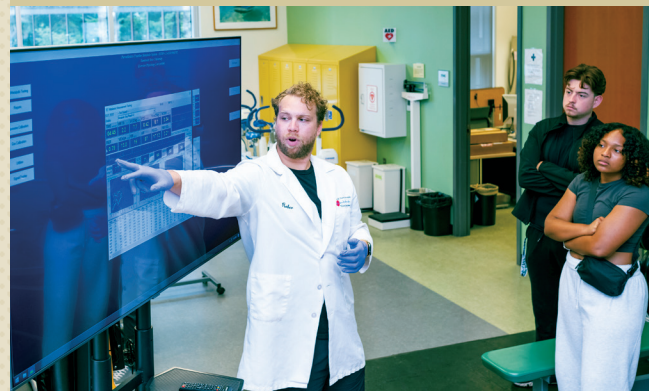
On-campus clinical service programs include fall prevention, clinical gait analysis, human performance and concussion assessment.
