<b>ARI Grants for Agricultural Research</b>	Agricultural Research Institute (ARI); CO Affinity Group	September	Early December	Early February	Based on annual ARI allocation; typically, \$250K total (applicants may apply for \$20,000-\$150,000 max.)	Tenured or tenure-track faculty engaging in agricultural research
<b>Incentives Program</b>	Cal Poly Humboldt SPF Board of Directors	End of September	Last Monday in January	Early March (after board meeting)	Based on annual budget approved by the Board in May; typically, \$40K total (applicants may apply for up to 4 WTU's or \$4,000 summer salary)	All Cal Poly Humboldt tenured/tenure-track faculty and Research Associates are eligible to apply
<b>Research and Creative Projects for Equity and Justice</b>	Cal Poly Humboldt SPF Board of Directors	October	mid-February	April 1st	\$40K annually	Tenured or tenure-track faculty, Research associates, Full-time MPPs (management personnel plan employees), Salaried directors of authorized centers or institutes, Visiting or emeritus faculty, Federal employees based on campus under cooperative agreements
<b>The McCrone Promising Faculty Scholars Award</b>	President's Office	November	Last Thursday in February	Mid April	\$1,500 ea.; Up to 3 Faculty Members Awarded	Tenured/Tenure track faculty who have received their terminal degrees within the last (7) years
<b>The Alistair and Judith McCrone Graduate Fellowship Fund</b>	Advancement Endowment	November	Last Thursday in February	Mid April	\$3,000 Scholarship Awarded to 1 Graduate Student	First year students who have been in their Cal Poly Humboldt Graduate Program for less than one academic year; enrolled full time (at least 9 units per semester), and have at least a 3.0 GPA
<b>CSU Student Research Competition</b>	Office of Research & Sponsored Programs	Late September	End of January	Early March	Travel funding to attend CSU wide competition; cash awards provided to the outstanding presenter and the runner-up in both the undergraduate and graduate divisions of each category	Undergraduate or graduate students currently enrolled at Cal Poly Humboldt as well as alumni/alumnae who received their degrees from Cal Poly Humboldt in Spring, Summer, or Fall of the awarding year
