

RESOLUTION ON FACULTY CONSULTATION ON
ENROLLMENT MANAGEMENT
(#26-93/94-EP)

- WHEREAS, Enrollment planning affects all aspects of the University; and
- WHEREAS, It is important to seek broad faculty input on enrollment planning before the plan is written and implemented; and
- WHEREAS, In the past, enrollment planning has been done primarily in the fall semester so that approval and implementation schedules preclude broad faculty consultation; therefore, be it
- RESOLVED: That the Academic Senate of Humboldt State University recommends that enrollment planning be done by the Academic Resources Allocation Committee so that the Academic Senate of Humboldt State University has an opportunity to participate in the development of the plan and to comment before the plan is approved and implemented; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That the Academic Senate of Humboldt State University recommends that the mechanism for department and college consultation on enrollment planning be made clear so that they have opportunity to participate in the planning process and to comment before the plan is approved and implemented.
