## **Summer Category II Fees**

Date: February 27, 2024

With the Summer term now stateside, Cal Poly Humboldt needs to formalize summer fee rates in alignment with historical approvals and applicable policies. A key aspect of formalizing fee rates is to establish a transparent and consistent approach for Summer Category II fee rates.

#### Background

Per the <u>CSU Student Tuition and Fee Policy</u>, Category II Fees are "campus mandatory fees that must be paid to enroll in or attend the university." Summer, like Fall and Spring, is a term where campus mandatory fees must be paid to enroll.

#### Prior Summer Documentation by Category II Fee

- <u>Student Body Association Fee (AS)</u> the last fee increase approval that specified Summer was in 2005, which specified a summer fee of \$50, aligned with Fall (\$51) and Spring (\$50); summer was not mentioned in the fee increases in 2014 or 2023 as they only referenced fall and spring, however summer was offered via self-support during this time
- Instructionally Related Activities Fee (IRA) the last fee increase approval that specified Summer was in 2007, which specified a summer fee of \$49, plus a per unit fee of \$16.75 up to a maximum of 12 units, with fall and spring part-time (\$149) and full-time (\$250) rates; the 2011 increase reflects a per semester rate increase, which would include summer, but did not directly mention the summer term
- Materials, Services & Facilities Fee (MSF) fee approved in 2010 based on a part-time and full-time fee rates by semester, with no mention of fall, spring or summer specifically; therefore, summer fee rates would be based on approved semester rates
- Health Facility Fee the last fee approval that specified Summer was in 2000, which specified a fee rate of \$3, aligned with fall (\$3) and spring (\$3); the 2018 rate increase was based on a semester rate, and did not reference specific terms, however the President's memo did reference an annual rate for information purposes based on fall + spring that did not include summer as it was offered via self-support at the time
- Student Health Fee the last fee approval that specified Summer was in 2000, which specified a fee rate of \$80 that was "to be waived for the summer session until services are offered"; recent fee increases have referenced semester or term rates and not specific terms, however one of the President's memos did reference an annual rate for information purposes based on fall + spring that did not include summer as it was offered via self-support at the time
- <u>Student Body Center Fee (Campus Union)</u> the last fee increase approval that specified Summer was in 2002, which specified a summer fee of \$92, aligned with Fall (\$93) and Spring (\$92); the 2019 increase reflects a per semester rate increase but did not directly mention summer term

#### Considerations

- Many of the historical campus Category II fee approvals reflect summer fee rates at the same level as fall and spring terms.
- The stateside Summer term offers two five week sessions and one eight week session, whereas the fall and spring terms are about 16 weeks long.

- Prior to Summer 2023, summer session had been offered via self support for many years and while recent approvals speak to semester or term rates more generally, recent fee approvals have not directly mentioned summer term rates
- Campuses do not have general discretion to waive fees and can only waive fees if an authorized fee waiver is applicable.
- Historically, over 80% of students enrolling in Summer take 6 units or less.
- Summer session fees at all campuses of the University of California and the California State
  University shall not exceed the fees charged per credit unit for any other academic term
  (Education Code 66057).

### **Proposal**

To simplify and clarify Category II summer term rates, propose to apply consistent summer term rates as a proportion of the already approved semester rates

- Benchmark summer fee rates at no more than 50% of part-time Fall/Spring term rates, approximating the difference in length of the academic term in Summer vs Fall/Spring.
- Summer would be the trailing term in terms of fee rates, so if a Category II fee increase was approved for Fall 2024, the increase would not apply until Summer 2025.
- All fee rates will be rounded to the nearest whole dollar.
- Category II fees would be assessed once during the summer term even if a student enrolls in more than one session, with the fees being assessed on the first unit taken
- For Category II fees where the service or facility is not provided during the summer, the fee will not be assessed. Partial service offerings to be evaluated on an individual basis.
  - o In the event that service is established or enhanced, the fee rate would be assessed at the applicable fee rate. Prior to implementation, notification will be provided to SFAC.
